Applications will be reviewed and successful candidates will be contact via email or phone regarding the next stage of the process.

Candidates will then attend three (3) consecutive Wednesday night training sessions with Lions Bay Fire Rescue members. Candidates will participate, with limitations, at training as determined by Training Officer and/or senior officer of the evening. More information will provided as process moves forward.

During the three (3) Wednesday training evening's candidates will have an interview with the Fire Chief and recruitment panel. Interview dates will be determined on the first Wednesday practice by the Fire Chief.

Further successful candidates will be contacted and required to attend a station orientation with a weekend shift. Details of station orientation will be provided when candidates are contacted.

Further successful candidates will be contacted about the Final Interview which date and location will be provided when candidates are contacted.

Successful candidates will then be offered the position of Paid On-Call Firefighter with Lions Bay Fire Rescue. At which point candidates will have to meet living boundary requirements and complete necessary preliminary training before recruit receives a pager and is authorized to attend emergency calls.
